Nurses Promote Role at Tournament of Roses

Nurses are often the unsung heroes of health care. A group of registered nurses in California has seized a way to recognize nursing at the 2013 Tournament of Roses. In that year, Sally Bixby, RN will preside over the Tournament of Roses. She was recently the director of surgical services at the City of Hope National Medical Center, Duarte, California.

Bixby's Presidency has provided a stage to honor all nurses by launching a campaign *Flowers 4 the Float* to design, build, and decorate a float to promote the nursing profession at the 2013 Rose Parade®. "Nursing has been a rewarding and fulfilling career for me," said Bixby. "I am thrilled and honored that my colleagues are promoting nursing during my tenure as president of the Tournament of Roses."

This founding group has formed a 501 (c) 3 non-profit organization, Bare Root, Inc. The Board of Directors is made up of registered nurse volunteers with skills that reflect the diversity of roles in nursing-management, marketing, education, and clinical expertise.

The campaign is designed at a grass-roots level. "There are millions of people whose lives have been touched in a positive way by nurses, says Monica Weisbrich, RN, president of Bare Root, Inc. "We encourage nurses and those who have been helped by nurses to go to our web site www.flowers4thefloat.org and contribute to help us meet our goal."

When people go to the website, they will be asked to contribute by a monetary donation, sending an eBouquet or eCard to someone, or shopping in our online store. One hundred percent of funds raised will go to the development of the Nurses Float, maintenance of the website, and marketing the project. All excess funds raised will be used for scholarships and grants to qualifying organizations.
